IF - CLAUSES

Type I: possible

If the weather is fine, I'll go for a walk.

if + present, will-future (will + infinitive)

Type II: improbable, impossible

If the weather were fine, I would go for a walk.

If I were you, I would call them.

If I spoke French, I could talk to them.

if + "past", conditional I (would + infinitive)

Type III: it was impossible (past)

If the weather had been fine, I would have gone for a walk.

if + past perfect, conditional II (would + have + past participle)
