

# IF - CLAUSES

## Type I: possible

If the weather **is** fine, I'll **go** for a walk.

**if + present, will-future** (will + infinitive)

## Type II: improbable, impossible

If the weather **were** fine, I **would go** for a walk.

If I **were** you, I **would call** them.

If I **spoke** French, I **could talk** to them.

**if + "past", conditional I** (would + infinitive)

## Type III: it was impossible (past)

If the weather **had been** fine, I **would have gone** for a walk.

**if + past perfect, conditional II** (would + have + past participle)
