ANY wird verwendet, wenn

- ✓ **ein Satz verneint ist.**
*She doesn't know **anybody** in Iceland.*
- ✓ **man auf die Frage, die man stellt, eine negative Antwort erwartet.**
*Have you got **any** brother?*
- ✓ **von irgendetwas oder irgendjemandem die Rede ist.**
*Do you know **anything** about that?*
*No, I don't know **anything** about that.*
*I don't know **anybody** in that city.*
